



## RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP YAMHILL COUNTY

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$84,670 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to three energy projects in Yamhill County. The funds are part of the State Energy Program and Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects.

The projects are expected to save an estimated 186,641 kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 15.6 average Oregon homes per year.

The City of Dayton received an award to install new lighting in the City Hall and Public Works complex. The old T-12 lights will be replaced with more energy-efficient T-8s. Savings per year are expected to be \$1,379.

Sheridan School District will use its awards to pay for a portion of a \$614,204 project to replace an aging, inefficient boiler at the high school with two high efficiency condensing boilers, install a high level direct digital control system, and install energy efficient lights at the high school and Faulconer-Chapman gym.
