**Subject: Oregon Department of Aviation comments regarding proposed construction of wind turbines near Arlington, Oregon.**  
**Aviation Reference: First Wind, Baseline Wind Project**

The Oregon Department of Aviation (ODA) has conducted an aeronautical review of the proposed wind farm and has determined that the turbines do not constitute a hazard to air navigation. The turbines all exceed required FAA notice criteria and ODA is aware that you have duly notified the FAA. However, ODA concludes that the turbines do not create a negative impact or hazard to the nearest airport, Arlington 1S8. This determination does not constitute FAA approval or disapproval of the physical development involved in the proposal. It is a determination by ODA with respect to the safe and efficient use of navigable airspace by aircraft.

#### **Marking and/or Lighting Recommendation**

The marking and lighting summary as presented in your original submission are acceptable to ODA providing they are installed and maintained in accordance with FAA Advisory Circular AC70/7460-1K.

Thank you for providing ODA the opportunity to comment on this wind farm.



The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has issued final "Determinations of No Hazard to Air Navigation" for the 226 Wind Turbines contained in the Baseline Wind Project in Arlington, OR.
